There is no doubt that trying to establish a new tree can be frustrating at times for most people. We certainly don't have all the answers, but we feel that if you use the following guidelines, your chances for success will increase greatly.

When is the first time I should water after installation of my new tree?

- Water the very next day. This will further settle the soil around the tree's roots.

OK, great! But what about after that? Is there a schedule I can follow to ensure that my tree will live?

- Unfortunately, there are no hard and fast rules for watering trees. Refer to the following schedule to assist you. Keep in mind that this schedule is **only a guideline** and may need to be adjusted to account for extended rains or droughts. **Note that the watering frequency is determined by temperature and assumes normal rainfall. Please contact our staff prior to making any adjustments in the schedule.** We recommend that you follow this schedule for **the first year** after your tree is planted.

New Tree Watering Schedule

Balled & Burlapped Trees		Type of tree:	
Temperature	Watering Frequency		
40 degrees and below	Water only before a hard freeze		
40-65 degrees	Water every 18 -22 days		
65-85 degrees	Water every 14 -17 days		
85-100 + degrees	Water every 11-14 days		
Container Grown Trees		Type of tree:	
Temperature	Watering Frequency		
40 degrees and below	Water every two to four weeks		
40-65 degrees	Water every 11 -14 days		
65-85 degrees	Water every 6 -10 days		
85-100 + degrees	Water every 3 - 5 days		
Every time you water, place a hose at the base of the tree and allow the water to run slowly for 20 to 30 minutes. Sprinklers do not water deeply enough!
